1. Present petition has been filed seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to ensure that fair and impartial action is taken in terms of the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the judgment reported as 'Lalita Kumar Vs. State of U.P. (2014) 2 SCC 1' on the representation dated 13.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner to the respondent No.3 by registration of a case followed by fair and impartial investigation in accordance with law.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed a representation dated 13.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioner would be satisfied if representation dated 13.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) is decided in a time bound manner.
