The prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. (Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023) R/w Section 439 Cr.P.C. (Section 483 BNSS, 2023) seeking concession of interim bail for a period of three weeks/20 days from the date of release of the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 15.02.2021 registered under Sections 148, 149, 201, 302 and 506 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Kaithal, District Kaithal on account of marriage and other ceremonies of the daughter of the petitioner from 01.11.2024 to 14.11.2024 (Annexure P-2).

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner will be solemnised on 13.11.2024 besides, other functions which are scheduled from 01.11.2024 onwards.

A reply dated 03.11.2024 by way of an affidavit of Kulwant Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Guhla has been filed on

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behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He contends that as per para No.17 of the reply filed today, the marriage of the daughter of the peitioner is scheduled for 13.11.2024 at PS Farm House, New Peoda Road, Near Gulmohar City, Kaithal.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above noted admitted factual position, the peitioner is ordered to be released on interim regular bail from 11.11.2024 (08.00 AM) to 14.11.2024 (08.00 AM) **in police custody**, the expenses of which shall be borne by the petitioner himself. The concerned Jail Superintendent is directed to make all the necessary arrangements and to ensure that no untoward incident occur during the time the petitioner is taken on interim regular bail as stated above.

The present petition stands disposed of.
