The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in cross-case registered against him vide G.D. No.28 dated 27.09.2023 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 427, 506, 120-B, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) in FIR No.0132 dated 27.09.2023 under Sections 324, 341, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC (Sections 326 and 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station Division No.2, District Panchkula.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 15.01.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 15.01.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
