1. Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the official respondents to get release the detenue Hiteshi, who is the wife of the petitioner, from the illegal custody of respondents No.3 to 7.

2. There is no representation for the petitioner when the matter is called. On the previous date of hearing as well, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel submits that even otherwise, the matter has become infructuous as the alleged detenue herself made a statement

before this Court on 21.12.2023 that she wanted to go with her father and not with the petitioner.

4. In view of above, present petition stands dismissed for want of prosecution.
