Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is coming to India on 07.11.2024 and shall move an appropriate application for providing security to him within a day before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.

To this, learned counsel for respondent No. 1 submits that the above said application shall be dealt with within a day thereafter by passing appropriate orders in view of the aforesaid terms.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present contempt petition, the same is disposed off.

It is made clear that respondent No. 1 shall bound by the aforesaid stand, as taken.
