1. On 29.10.2024, this Court had passed the hereinafter
extracted order, upon the instant petition:-

“Through the instant petition, filed under Section 482 of
BNSS of 2023, prayer is made for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR
No. 0158 dated 25.8.2024, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 191(3),
190,351(3) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima,
District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia submits that
the co-accused Harsh Deep Singh @ Harsh Suniara has been granted
the relief of interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 28.10.2024 and
the petitioner is co-equal pedestal with him. He further submits that the
injuries which are attributed to the present petitioner are simple in
nature.

Mr. Pardeep Bajaj, DAG, Punjab waives service on
behalf of the respondent-State.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner
shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal and
surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.
The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation as and when called
for and shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section
482(2) of the Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-53549-2024. ”

2. Today, the learned State counsel has, on instructions imparted to her by the official concerned, stated that pursuant to the making of the hereinabove extracted order, the petitioner(s) had joined investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

3. She has also filed a short reply, dated 02.12.2024, by way of an affidavit of Sh.Jaspal Singh, ACP (Central), Amritsar City, today in court, which is ordered to be taken on record.

4. In view of the above, the hereinabove extracted interim order dated 29.10.2024, is hereby made **absolute**, subject to the hereinafter extracted conditions:-

- “(i) the petitioner(s) shall not commit an offence similar to the present offence;
- (ii) the petitioner(s) shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case;
- (iii) the petitioner(s) shall make himself/herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required.”

5. This order should not be treated as “blanket” order. It will not be read granting petitioner(s) indefinite protection from arrest. It shall be confined to the FIR mentioned *ibid* and will not operate in respect of any other incident that involves commission of an offence.

6. Needless to say that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.

7. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
