1. Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, who are residing in live-in-relationship from the hands of respondents No.5 to 10.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No.1 is unmarried and a divorce petition was filed by respondent No.11 i.e. the wife of petitioner No.2, however, later on the same was withdrawn.
3. On the issuance of the notice, Mr. Tekwinder Singh Rai, Advocate has put in appearance and filed power of attorney on behalf of respondents No.5, 6, 9 & 10, in the Court. However, as per office report, notice issued to respondent No.11 has been received back unserved with the report that she is married and now residing with her in-law.



5. Heard. After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga is directed to decide the representation dated 25.10.2024 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioners expeditiously, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
