SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE, (ORAL)

1. The challenge in this petition is to the impugned notices (Annexures P-14 and P-17) by which the petitioner has been expelled from the membership of District Bar Association, Rewari and he has been asked to deposit an amount of Rs.38,83,027/- in favour of the District Bar Association, Rewari and also to vacate Chamber No. 251 of Lawyers' Chambers, Block No.1, Rewari.
2. This matter was taken up in the pre-lunch session.
3. Mr. C.M. Munjal, Advocate, who ordinarily appears for the Bar Council of State of Punjab and Haryana was directed to seek instructions.
4. When the case is taken up in the post lunch session, Sh. C.M. Munjal, Advocate assures that during pendency of appeal (Annexure P-15)



preferred by the petitioner against notice (Annexure P-14), no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner including evicting him from Chamber No.251 of Lawyers’ Chambers, Block-1, Rewari. He further states that the Bar Council shall prevail upon the President of the District Bar Association, Rewari not to take coercive steps against the petitioner, including vacating of Chamber No.251 of Lawyers’ Chambers, Block-1, Rewari, subject to the final order in appeal.

5. It is also submitted by Sh. C.M. Munjal that the appeal will be decided as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 30 days.
6. With these observation, the petition stands disposed of.
