SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. This is first regular bail application in FIR No. 69 dated 11.09.2024 for offence punishable under Section 110 of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station SGN Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda, filed by the petitioner, who happens to be father of the deceased and is alleged to have injected fatal drug in the body of his son, who succumbed to the said injection.
2. Learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, informs that the charge sheet has recently been filed before the trial court on 09.11.2024 and the case is now fixed for framing of charge.
3. Considering the gravity of the offence and the fact that investigation is over and trial is likely to begin soon, this Court for the time being declines to grant bail to the petitioner, with liberty to him to re-visit the Court, in case trial is delayed.
4. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed with the aforesaid liberty.
