1. A perusal of the instant petition reflects that, in fact the instant petition is a misconceived motion, inasmuch as, despite the petitioner being seized of an alternate and efficacious statutory remedy for redressal of his grievance, yet he has sidetracked the said remedy and have straightway accessed this Court, through instituting the present petition under Section 528 of the BNS Act, 2023, for quashing of the FIR bearing No.83, dated 11.05.2017, under Sections 304-A, 279, 337 and 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga (Annexure P-1).

2. Faced with the above difficulty, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the instant petition,

however, with liberty reserved to the petitioner to recourse with an alternative available statutory remedy(ies) before the appropriate court/authority/forum concerned, for redressal of his grievance, as per law.
