1. Petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents to grant eight weeks parole to the petitioner to meet his family members under Section 3(1)(d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962. It is further prayed that parole case of petitioner was forwarded by respondent No.4 vide Dispatch No.DC/3066 dated 11.06.2024 and till date no decision has been taken by respondent No.3.
