The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.290, dated 15.10.2024, under Sections 3,4,5 of MTP Act, 18(a), 18(c) of Drugs and Cosmetic Act, 15(2) of IMC Act and 125,318(4), 61(2) of BNS Act, registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal, Haryana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned counsel for the petitioner has also voluntarily filed the affidavit of present petitioner, whereby, he submitted that he will close the Life Care Nursing Home at Bighawali with immediate effect.
3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 04.12.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner

shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
