1. Instant seventh petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail to the petitioner in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Section
262	08.10.2019	Lehra District Sangrur	22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985

2. Counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to order dated 24.05.2023, Annexure P-7, whereby one of the previous petitions was withdrawn. He submits that the prosecution has concluded its evidence and statement of the accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C. has been recorded on 31.03.2023. By making a reference to the interim orders passed by the trial Court, he submits that proceedings are being adjourned for defence evidence as well as for arguments. He has instructions to state that petitioner has already produced all the witnesses



in defence and no further defence evidence is to be led. While seeking permission to withdraw the petition, he has sought direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial in a time bound manner.

3. Request of the counsel for the petitioner seems to be reasonable and is accepted. Petition is permitted to be withdrawn.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
5. Trial Court is requested to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of communication of a copy of this order.
