1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 204 dated 11.10.2023 for the offences under Sections 326, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar.

2. On the last date of hearing, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel, while drawing the attention of this Court to the allegations levelled in the FIR, which has been annexed as Annexure P-1, inter alia contends that a perusal of the same reveals that though the petitioner’s name finds reflected therein, however, he has just been attributed fist blows on the person of the complainant.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 22.11.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjeet Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents and is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 07.12.2023 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
