1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.101, dated 24.08.2024, registered under Sections 420,120-B of IPC, at Police Station Khilchian, District Amritsar (Rural).
2. Vide order dated 31.10.2024, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully Co-operated with the I.O in the present case.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raswinder Singh also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 31.10.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner

shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.

The petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.4.10 lacs with the Trial Court/Area Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate within a period of two weeks from today and the concerned Court is directed to get a FDR prepared in the name of the Court in some nationalised bank, fetching maximum rate of interest, subject to outcome of the trial. The concerned Court is also directed to comply with the order strictly.

Pending application(s), if any, stand(s), disposed of, accordingly.
