*Counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR, Annexure P1
has been registered on the basis of a secret information, and petitioner has
been named. She submits that the allegation is that a vehicle with an
injured Ox was recovered and the petitioner ran away from the spot taking
advantage of the dark. She submits that no implement was recovered nor
does the State possess any incriminating material against the petitioner,
who has clean antecedents and is prepared to join the investigation.*

On asking of the Court, Mr.Munish Sharma, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State.

Let the State apprise the Court about the medical condition of the Ox. Petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 08.12.2023 at 10:00 A.M. at Police Station Rozka Meo, District Nuh, and join the investigation and appear as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

[2] Today, learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Balvir Singh, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 23.11.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[3] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 23.11.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
