Learned counsel for petitioner relies upon a communication dated 3.12.2024 from the office of Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, to contend that the name of the petitioner has been recommended for the post of PGT (Punjabi).

Learned State counsel on instructions from Ashok Sharma, Superintendent, o/o Director Secondary Education, Haryana, submits that the process for grant of appointment in favour of petitioner shall be concluded alongwith grant of notional benefits within a period of three weeks from today.

In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner does not press the aforesaid petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore- stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
