1. Status report by way of an affidavit of Satwinder Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Industrial Area-B, Ludhiana filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State is taken on record along with Annexure R-1 i.e. copy of the inquiry report.
2. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Harpal Singh submit that police officials never harassed the petitioner in an unnecessary manner and petitioner is not required by the police as an accused in any criminal case in Police Station Division No.6, Ludhiana till date.
3. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the present petition be disposed of in light of the aforesaid statement made by the State counsel.
4. Ordered accordingly.
5. However, it is made clear that even in future, the police officials are not interfere into the possession of the person who is occupying the property in question except in due course of law.
