1. Notice of motion.
2. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Vivek Saini, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and refers to a speaking order dated 11.11.2024, whereby, the claim of the petitioner has been considered and adjudicated upon.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, further submits that the necessary payments in terms of aforesaid order dated 11.11.2024 shall be released in favour of the petitioner within a period of 03 weeks from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not

pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
