1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the official respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.7 & 8.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 22.10.2024 (Annexure P-1).
3. In view of the above, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot is directed to look into the representation dated 22.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same after providing the opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. The petitioner will be at liberty to produce and rely upon any material document as deemed necessary for adjudication of the instant representation.
6. The petition is disposed off, accordingly.
