1. The petitioner in the instant (second) petition is seeking the concession of interim bail under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for a period of eight weeks, in complaint case with NCB Crime No.11/2023 dated 13.05.2023 under Sections 8, 15, 25, 27-A, 29, 60 and 62 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station NCB, Chandigarh.

2. In compliance of order dated 04.11.2024, learned standing counsel for the respondent-NCB has filed the duly attested copy of the OPD card of PGIMER, Chandigarh as well LNJP, Kurukshetra in the Court today which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. Learned standing counsel submits that the medical condition of the petitioner is being regularly and routinely being monitored by the jail

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doctors as per advice rendered by the doctors at PGIMER, Chandigarh and also LNJP, Kurukshetra. It has been submitted that no such advice has been given by the Department of Cardiology at PGIMER, Chandigarh that the petitioner requires to undergo angioplasty. It has been further submitted that in case in future the petitioner requires to undergo angioplasty, he would be promptly removed to PGIMER, Chandigarh, for carrying out the said procedure.

3. In the circumstances, no ground is made out to extend the concession of interim bail to the petitioner. The instant petition stands dismissed accordingly.
