1 The petitioner has filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioner and also direct the respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 15.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana and he shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their aforesaid representation.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. I.P.S. Sabherwal, DAG, Punjab, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2- the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

7. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.
8. With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
