1. In the present petition the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of implementation of the recommendations of the 6th pay commission but the said benefit has not been granted to her and her pay scale has not been revised which is causing prejudice.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance which has been raised in the present petition has already been raised in the legal notice dated 30.09.2024 copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-3 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is given to respondents to pass an appropriate order on the claim of the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Shruti, AAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the legal notice dated 30.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
