1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to official respondents No.3 to 5 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.154 dated 14.07.2022 under Sections 323, 342, 354, 354-A, 379-B, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioners had been wrongly implicated as accused in the FIR (*supra*) and the representation submitted by them has not been considered by the investigating agency and the investigation has not been conducted in a fair and impartial manner.
3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and on instructions from ASI Amandeep Singh, submits that the investigating agency has already concluded the investigation and filed the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate. In the original chargesheet, 03 prosecution witnesses have been examined and supplementary chargesheet against remaining accused has already been filed.

5. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, no directions are required to be issued in the present petition. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to raise all the pleas taken in the present petition at the appropriate stage during the course of trial.

6. The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
