The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.248 dated 05.07.2023 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Soahana, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.01.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
