NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioners have approached this Court by way of filing the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to the respondents to release the pensionary benefits i.e. gratuity, leave encashment etc. along with interest @ 9%.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that after filing of the present petition, pensionary benefits have been released to the petitioners, however, no interest thereon has been granted. He submits that for claiming the interest, petitioners shall file a detailed representation and the same may be ordered to be considered in a time-bound manner.
3. Learned counsel for respondents No.3 to 7 submits that if any representation, claiming interest on the pensionary benefits, is filed

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by the petitioners, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously in accordance with the relevant rules/instructions.

4. Petitioner will be at liberty to submit the said representation within a period of two weeks from today and the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents in accordance with law within a period of four weeks thereafter.

5. Disposed of in the above terms.
