The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks entrustment of the investigation in FIR No. 107 dated 02.04.2021 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 302, 201, 436, 428, 427 & 34 of IPC read with Section 3(2) (V) SC/ST Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Jhajjar, to some independent agency.

[2] Upon notice, status report by way of affidavit dated 29.01.2024 of Sh. Shamsher Singh, HPS, DSP, City Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, filed on behalf of the respondents-State is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the opposite side.

[3] In the aforesaid status report, it has been pointed out that the investigation in the FIR (supra) was initially concluded on 13.08.2021; thereafter the petitioner moved an application before the DGP (Crime) and in pursuance thereof, the investigation of the FIR (supra) was transferred to State Crime Branch, upon which, the final report was received by the concerned police Station on 22.02.2023, followed by issuance of two notices

to the complainant, fetching no result, thereby delaying the presentation of the final report before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned.

[4] Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Rajesh Kumar, submits that the final report shall be presented before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned within a period of two weeks from today with an advance intimation to the petitioner.

[5] Considering the fact that the investigation in the present case already having been conducted by the State Crime Branch and the fact that the final report is going to be presented before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned within a period of two weeks from today, no further cause survives in the present petition; the same is **disposed off** accordingly.
