This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 11.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-4919-2019.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of order dated 02.02.2024 passed by the respondent, vide which, the claim of the petitioner has been rejected. Copy of said order is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent.
