This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 29.05.2023 passed by this Court in CRM-M-27397-2023.

Mr. Jaideep Verma, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Affidavit dated 30.01.2024 of respondent No.1 filed in the Registry is taken on record. Learned State counsel has submitted that the order dated 29.05.2023 passed in CRM-M-27397-2023 has been complied with and representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 20.06.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent.
