Ms. Shruti, AAG Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and submits that in case any representaiton is received at the hands of petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of the certified copy of this order and in case, after consideration claim of the petitioner seems feasible, same will be accepted otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner, which will be duly conveyed to her.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

5. It is directed that respondent No.7 be also given opportunity of personal hearing of case before dedicing the claim of the petitioner.
