1. On 09.12.2024, the following order was passed:-

“On 04.12.2024, the following order was passed:-

“The learned counsel representing the State of Punjab admits that no final report in FIR No.342, dated 26.12.2015, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 has been filed till date.

On a court question, as to whether it is permissible to file a final report, at this stage, the learned counsel as well as the Police officer assisting him feign ignorance of law.

Keeping in view the circumstances, this court directs the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to virtually attend the hearing of the case on the next date of hearing
