1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the official respondents to conduct the fair and impartial investigation in case arising out of FIR No. 138, dated 24.08.2024 under Sections 406,420,379 of IPC, registered at Police Station Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 05.10.2024 (Annexure P-8) to the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra-respondent No.2 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, to look into representation dated 05.10.2024 (Annexure P-8) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
