By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.,
2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as
under:

212	07.10.2023	306 of IPC	Samrala, Khanna, District Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 28.11.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 28.11.2023.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parminder Singh intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

4. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

5. During the course of hearing on 28.11.2023, following order was passed:

“ Contends, inter alia, that petitioner is 19 years of age and having no role with the alleged suicide by deceased- Pardeep Singh.

Notice of motion.

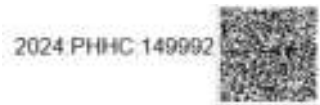
On asking of the Court, Mr. C.L.Pawar, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and seeks time to have instructions and/or file written response in the matter.

Mr. D.S.Nigha, Advocate has filed Power of Attorney on behalf of the complainant.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit her to interim bail in the present case, till the next date of hearing, on furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. ”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 28.11.2023 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 28.11.2023 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by

way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
8. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
