1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing order dated 02.04.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by District Magistrate, Gurugram under Section 14 of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (for short 'SARFAESI Act') and notice dated 19.03.2019 issued under Section 13 (2) of SARFAESI Act.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner, who has filed this writ petition, has passed away. Notice to the petitioner was issued on 03.10.2023. As per office report, petitioner is unserved for want of complete address.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent – Bank, however, points out that this writ petition is rendered infructuous because petitioner's account has been settled under One Time Settlement and closed on 11.04.2023. Reference has been made to email dated 06.03.2024 received

by him. Copy thereof is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

4. There is no representation on behalf of petitioner. However, in view of categorical statement made by learned counsel for respondent -Bank, we find no justification for continuation of present proceedings.

5. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. In case, any incorrect fact has been placed before us, petitioner is at liberty to file appropriate application within four weeks.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
