1. Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of private respondents and to take legal action against them pursuant to FIR No.124 dated 22.06.2023 under Sections 363 & 366-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.
2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rattan Singh, submits that the grievance raised by the petitioners in the present petition has substantially been redressed. The victim-prosecutrix has been recovered and

her statement under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. (*now Section 183 of BNSS*) has been recorded and her custody has been handed over to her parents. Further, one accused has already been arrested and efforts are being made to apprehend the remaining accused.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
