 This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 12.08.2013 passed in CWP-1197-2013.

 Reply on behalf of respondent No.1 is already on record.

 As per the said reply, and it has also been so argued by learned State counsel that, necessary approval for sale have already been granted by the State. Therefore, the order passed by the Writ Court stands complied with.

 In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

 However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
