 This is an application for placing on record the short reply on behalf of respondent No.3.

 For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Short reply on behalf of respondent No.3 is taken on record.

Main Case

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 29.03.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-6185-2019.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 filed by learned State counsel today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Learned State counsel has submitted that the order dated 29.03.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-6185-2019 has been complied with and speaking order dated 03.01.2024 has been passed. Additionally, a cheque No.048369

dated 15.01.2024 for an amount of Rs.15,85,424/- in the name of the petitioner has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner towards payment of arrears arising from consequential benefits. Photocopy of said cheque is taken on record.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
