1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioner has filed a complaint/representation dated 04.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) before respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patila raising their grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioners would feel satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid

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complaint/representation filed by the petitioners and take necessary action thereon.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

4. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid complaint/representation of the petitioners within a period of one month from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioners, the official respondents would provide them adequate security in order to protect their life and liberty.
