ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (Oral)

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach DRT under Section 17 of SARFAESI Act. He submits that the petitioners are the widow and daughters of Late Sanjeev Chathrath, who was co-borrower and they were not aware of the proceedings under SARFAESI Act and could not file SA within a period of limitation. He, therefore, submits that petitioners may be permitted to file SA before the DRT within reasonable time.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

The petitioners may prefer SA before the DRT within a period of 15 days from today and in the event of their doing so, the SA would be heard and decided on merits.
