1. The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to immediately issue him a passport.
2. The learned counsel representing the respondent submits that there is a small query which the Regional Passport Officer, Amritsar, would like to ask from the petitioner before taking a decision. He submits that the petitioner can visit the office of Regional Passport Office, Amritsar, at 10.00 am, on 25.11.2024, and the matter will be resolved there and then.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand of the respondent, the writ petition is disposed of with the observation that the Regional Passport Officer, Amritsar, will pass an appropriate speaking order within a period of one week from 25.11.2024, if the passport is to be denied to the petitioner.

3. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
