1. Through the instant second petition, filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), a prayer is made for grant of relief of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.79, dated 05.10.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 22 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar.
2. Custody Certificate dated 10.11.2024, qua the petitioner, furnished by learned State counsel today, in the Court. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof, supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. There is no supervening or changed circumstances in the instant matter, after the first regular bail application vide CRM-M-21163-2024, having been dismissed as withdrawn, vide order dated 14.08.2024, and without waiting further for the progress of the trial, the instant petition has

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been filed, within a period of three months approximately. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to consider the case of the present petitioner, to grant the asked for relief (supra).

4. Accordingly, the instant petition is, hereby, **dismissed**.
