1. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and directing respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioner and for taking strict legal action against respondents No.4 & 5 for their illegal activities and further for issuing directions to protect the life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5, who are roaming freely causing apparent threat to the petitioner. Further prayer has been made to decide the representation dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed a representation dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, Ludhiana (Rural) but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioners would be satisfied if representation dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) is decided in a time bound manner.

After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, Ludhiana (Rural), is directed to decide the representation dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.
