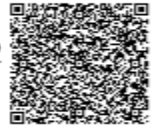

1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya  
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.52 dated  
09.08.2024 (*wrongly mentioned as 09.02.2024*) under Sections 323, 354-C,  
354-D, 509 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') and Section  
67-A of Information Technology Act, 2000 (for short 'I.T. Act'), registered  
at Women Police Station, Sirsa, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1) along with all



subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 28.10.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 07.11.2024: -

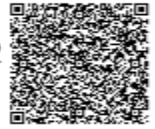
*“This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.52 dated 09.02.2024 under Sections 323/354-C/354-D/509 of IPC and Section 67-A of I.T. Act, 2000 registered at PS Women Police Station, Sirsa, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 28.10.2024 (Annexure P-2).*

*Notice of motion for 11.12.2024.*

*At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and Ms. Manvi Arora, Advocate accepts notice for respondent No.2 and files her vakalatnama and admits to the factum of compromise. Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.*

*Service is complete.*

*In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get their statements recorded regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed.*



*A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.”*

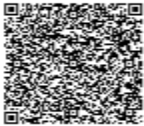
3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR (*supra*) was registered on 09.08.2024, however, it has been wrongly mentioned as 09.02.2024, as such, a typographical mistake has crept in, in the head note and prayer clause. It is thus prayed that date of FIR (*supra*) may be ordered to be corrected as 09.08.2024 instead of 09.02.2024, in the head note and prayer clause.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Registry is directed to make necessary corrections accordingly.

7. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466, Ramgopal and another Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh 2021 SCC OnLine SC 834 and Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63*** and Full Bench of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052***, this petition is allowed and FIR No.52 dated 09.08.2024 under



Sections 323, 354-C, 354-D, 509 of IPC and Section 67-A of I.T. Act, registered at PS Women Police Station, Sirsa, District Sirsa and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioner.
