This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobedience of the order dated 01.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-16469-2023.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent has been filed by learned counsel for the respondent today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the petitioner has been granted promotion, vide order dated 24.01.2024 and the main writ petition qua which the contempt is alleged, itself stands disposed of as having become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
