MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.299 dated 05.11.2023 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341, 506 of the IPC (Section 325 of the IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Nathu Sarai, District Sirsa.

2. On 15.12.2023, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned State counsel, on instructions, has reiterated the allegations levelled in the FIR in question, however, she has not controverted the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner in the Court today that no specific injury had been attributed to the petitioner, who admittedly is an 85 years old man.”

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 15.12.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satbi, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. She, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.
5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 15.12.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
