The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.424 dated 24.10.2023 registered under Sections 120-B IPC, 1860, Sections 181, 192 and 192A of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and Section 61 of the Punjab EXCUSW Act, 1914 at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 28.11.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hakumuddin admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 28.11.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
