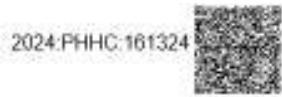

HARKESH MANUJA, J (ORAL)

Learned counsel for respondents on instructions from Mr. Shashi Gagg, Assistant Registrar, (Legal) submits that case of the petitioners shall be reconsidered on furnishing of fresh particulars.

For the said purpose, learned counsel for respondents submits that the petitioners may appear in the office of Director School Education, Punjab, on Monday i.e. 9.12.2024 at 11:00 a.m. and furnish requisite information and thereupon case of the petitioners shall be reconsidered within one week.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the present petition, however, in case, any claim of the petitioners still survives, they would be at liberty to raise their claim by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from the release of payments, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent, the officer concerned would be liable to pay cost(s) of Rs.50,000/- to the petitioners from his/her own pocket.

Dismissed as not pressed with liberty aforesaid.

Rule stands discharged.
