Through the instant petition, filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, a prayer is made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.26 dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420 and 406 of the IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Crime Wing, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab.
2. On asking for the relief (supra), learned counsel for the petitioner, on the previous occasion, has made the statement that the petitioner is ready and willing to settle the dispute with the complainant, and sought an adjournment, thereby, enabling him to place on record a settlement proposal.
