1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to transfer the inquiry of representation dated 02.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) to some higher police officer as the cognizable offence is made out against the private respondents.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed aforesaid representation on 02.11.2023 before respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana raising her grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would feel satisfied if appropriate directions are

issued to respondent No. 3 to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

4. Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 3 to decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and take action, if so required.
