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Present petition has been filed seeking direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 for taking action against respondent Nos.5 to 8 in case FIR No.166 dated 30.09.2023 registered under Sections 341, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station West Sector 11, District Chandigarh and further direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to ensure the fair investigation of the case.

2. Mr. Vijay Pratap Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.5 and 6 and filed his *vakalatnama* which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel for U.T., Chandigarh has filed status report dated 01.01.2024 by way of affidavit of DSP Gurmukh Singh, SDPO Central, U.T.

Chandigarh on behalf of respondent No.1 which is taken on record subject to

all just exceptions and submits that police is taking all effective steps to conclude the investigation and refers to para No.5 of the status report, which shows that respondent Nos.5 and 6 have been arrested by the investigating officer on 14.12.2023.

4. In view of the status report filed, the grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition has been substantially redressed. As such, no further directions are required in the matter.
